



Code of Conduct of the Socialist Workers Movement of Kenya (SOWOMO)

1. Members of SOWOMO shall always be dedicated to building an equitable and socially just society, free from oppression, exploitation, and injustice in both word and deed.
2. SOWOMO members must promote international working-class unity, comradeship, and solidarity with all oppressed and marginalized peoples around the world.
3. SOWOMO members shall actively study, uphold, and disseminate the movement's manifesto, constitution, laws, and principles with full loyalty and conviction.
4. SOWOMO members shall continuously seek knowledge of socialism and other revolutionary and progressive ideologies for personal and collective development.
5. Members of SOWOMO shall engage in active advocacy and action—both verbal and physical—for the liberation of all exploited and oppressed communities.
6. It is forbidden for SOWOMO members to practice, condone, or tolerate any form of discrimination, including racism, sexism, xenophobia, tribalism, nepotism, or cronyism.
7. SOWOMO members shall always uphold truthfulness, socialist morality, and integrity, refraining from corruption, false claims, or divisive behavior.
8. Members of SOWOMO shall foster respect, friendship, unity, and tolerance, while avoiding conduct that could harm the cohesion or progress of the movement.
9. Members of SOWOMO organs shall adhere to democratic centralism, promoting internal democracy, discipline, accountability, and responsible leadership.
10. SOWOMO members are forbidden from disclosing internal matters or engaging in public behavior, including on social media, that could damage the movement's image or goals.
